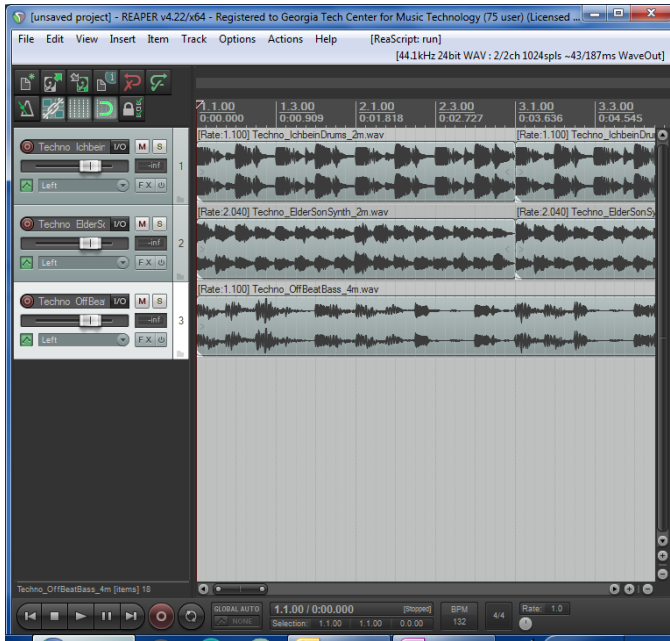


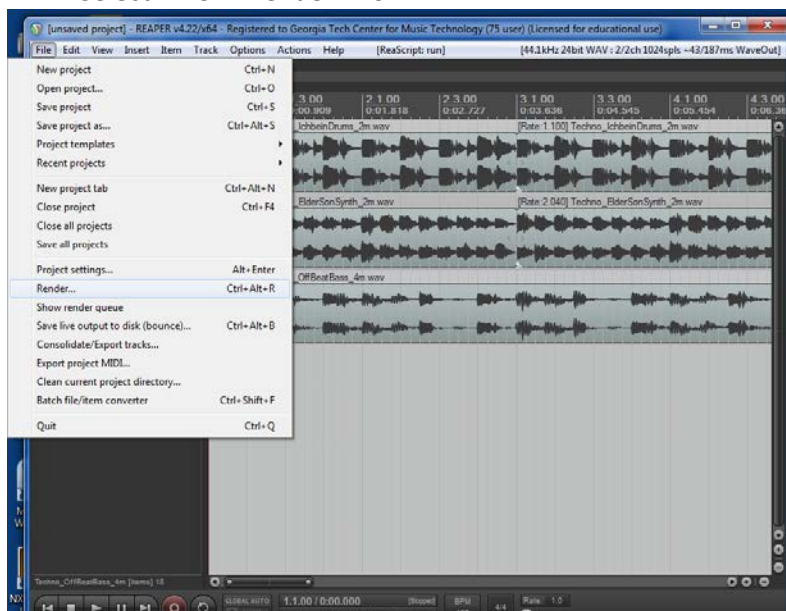
REAPER projects cannot be saved directly and run on other devices (such as phones or portable music players.) To play a music file on another device you must "render" the REAPER remix into a ".wav" file. We will also use "16 bit depth" when rendering to make the .wav music file compatible with most devices.

Directions:

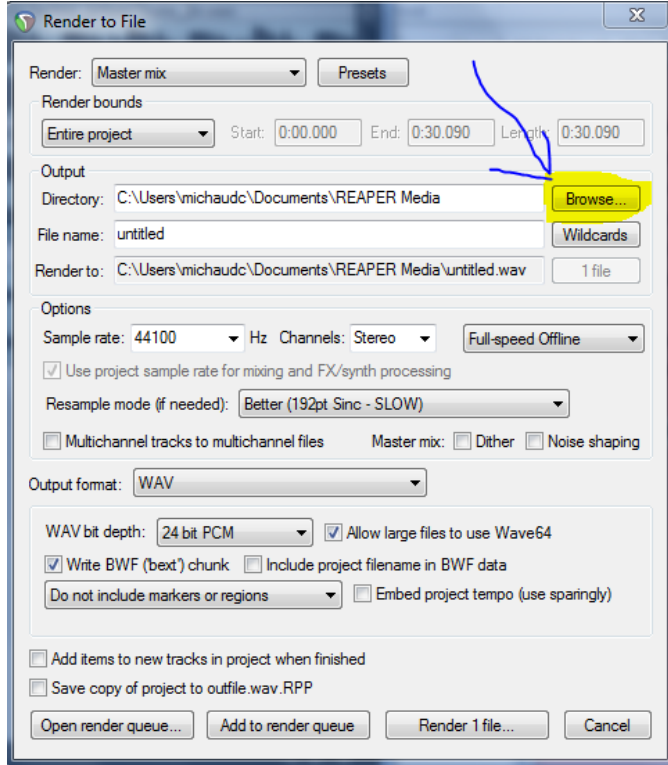
1. Run your EarSketch script in REAPER to have your music ready to play.



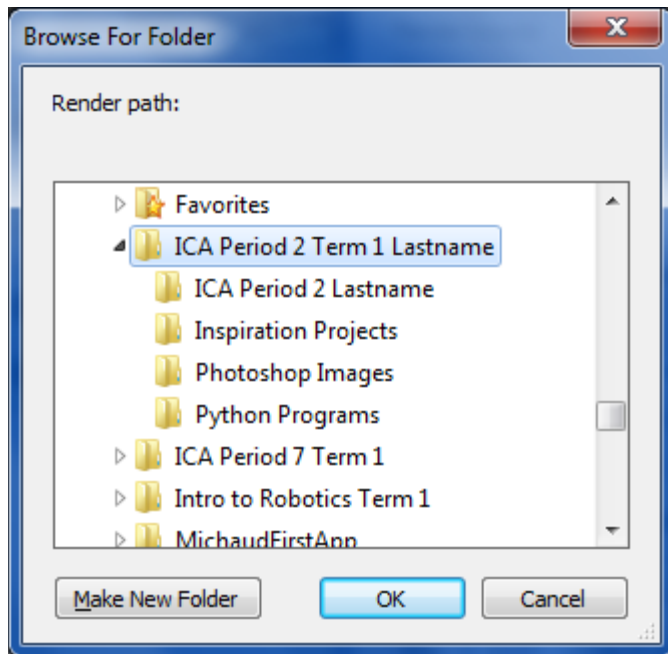
2. Select "File -> Render" from REAPER



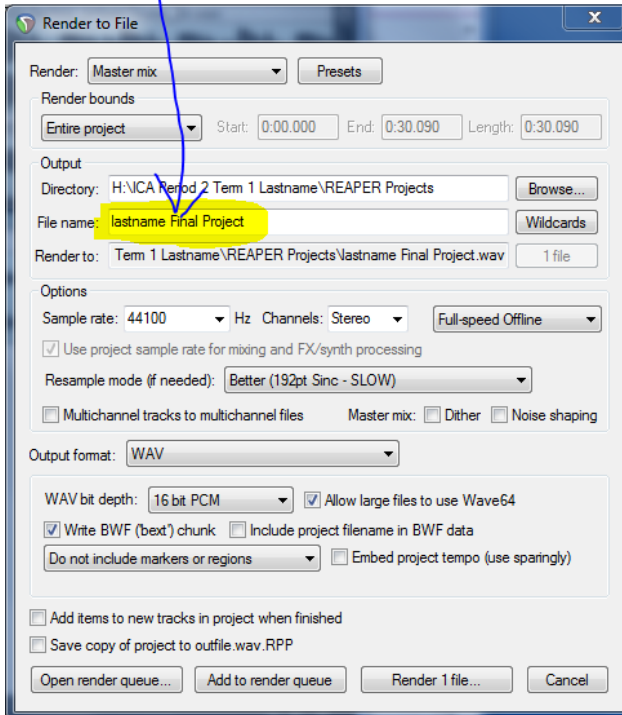
3. Click "Browse" to select your File Area



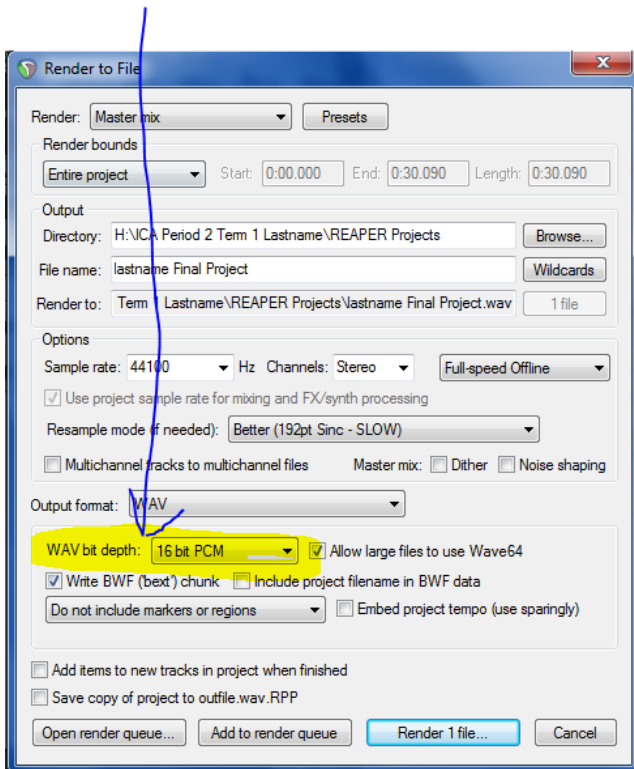
4. Navigate to Your H Space ICA Folder.



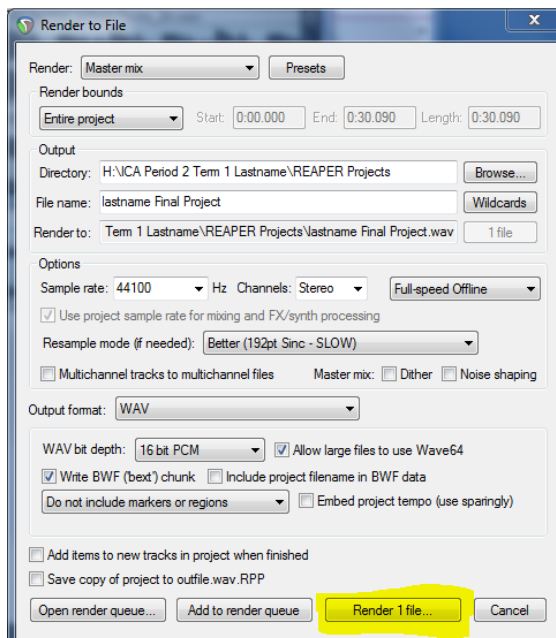
5. Navigate to your "EarSketch Projects Folder."
6. Name your project: "Lastname Final Project"



7. Change the "WAV bit depth" to "16 bit PCM"



8. Click "Render 1 file"



9. Your project has been rendered as a .wav file. It can now be played on other devices.
