

## Setting Up your EarSketch Account

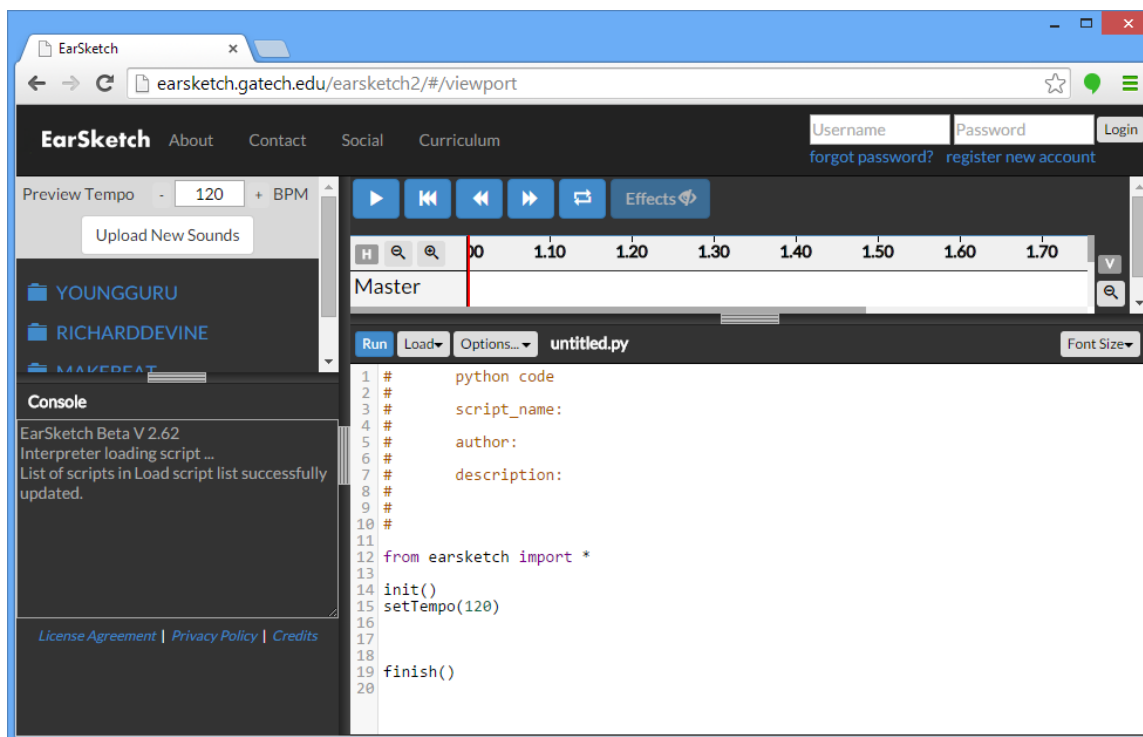

#### Description:

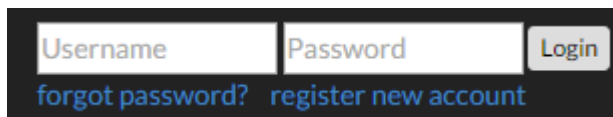
These directions will work through how to register for an EarSketch account. This allows you to save your programming in the EarSketch website. You will need to use your Marist username and create a password.

#### Process:


1. Go to <http://earskech.gatech.edu/earskech2/#/viewport>



2. Click on "register new account"



3. Fill out the registration form. For Description write "student". Join the public community and click "Done".




