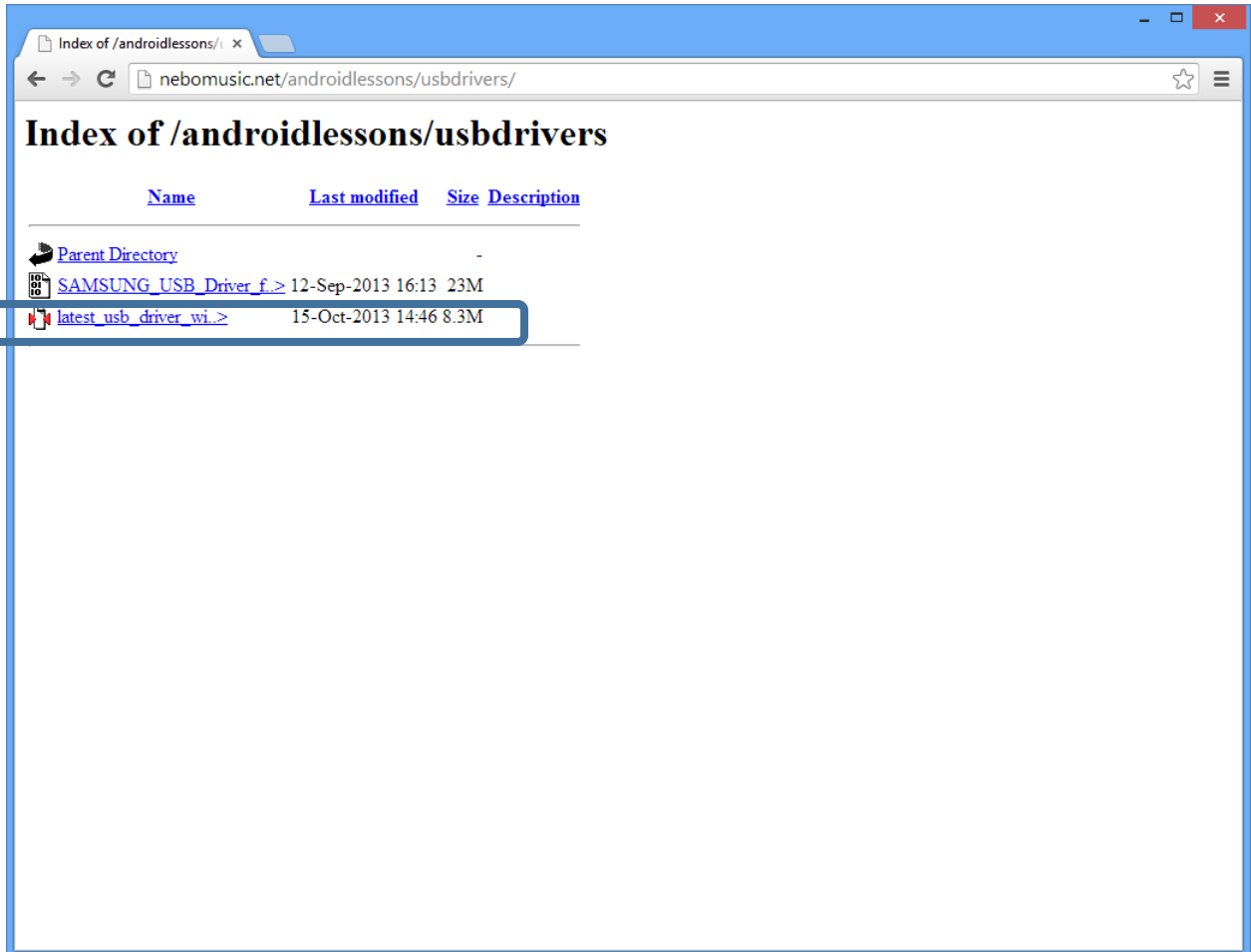


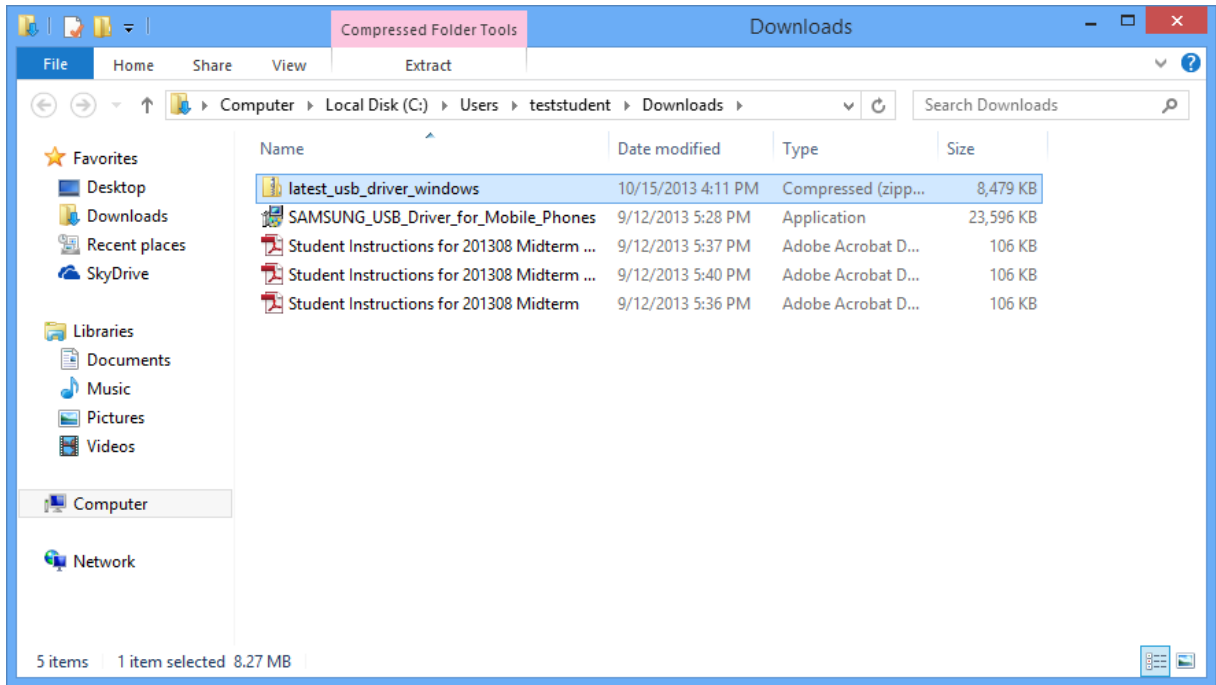
Steps to Install the Android USB Driver for Google Nexus Phone

1. Go to the Mobile Apps Page and Click on USB Drivers link under downloads. You should see a list of drivers: (<http://nebomusic.net/androidlessons/usbdriers/>)

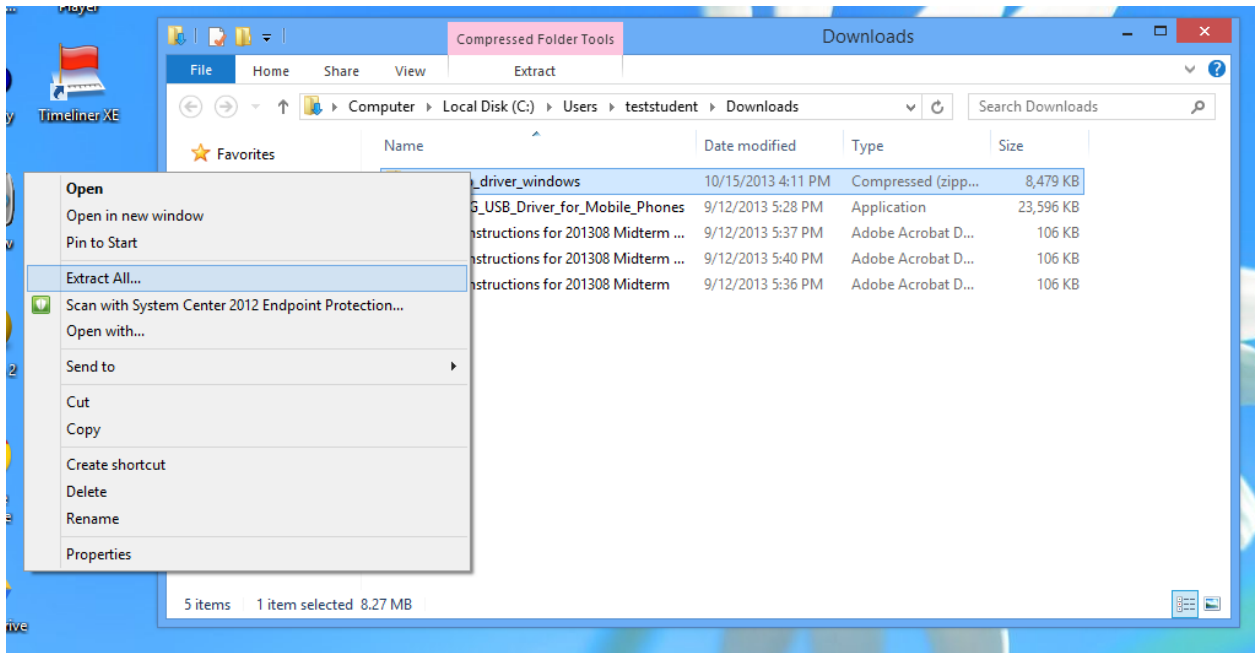


2. Click on the link titled "latest_usb_driver_wi . ." to download the driver.

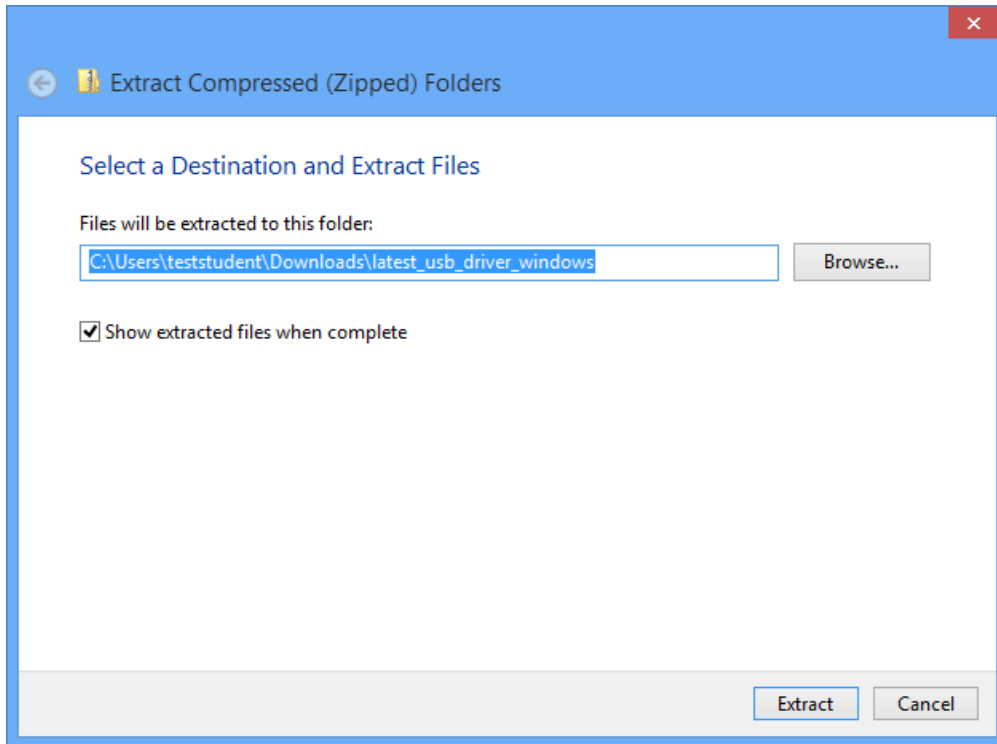
3. Go to your Downloads folder where the latest_usb driver was downloaded.



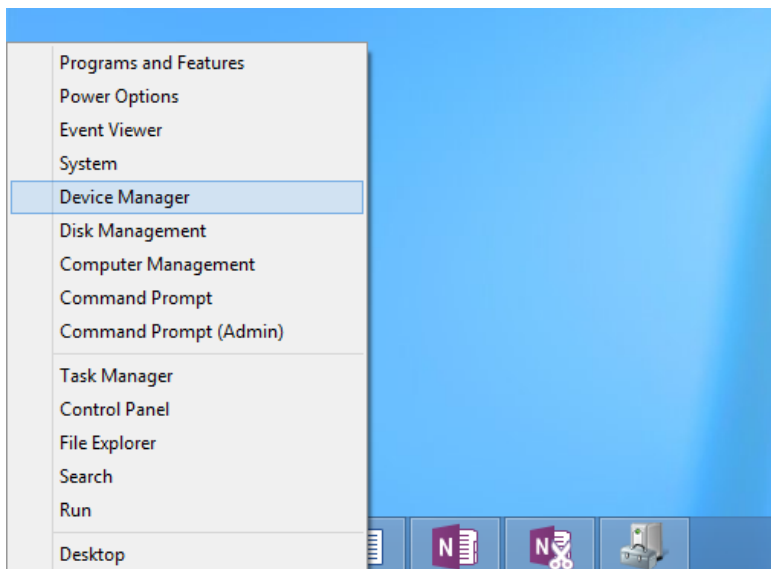
4. Right click on the zip file "latest_driver" and select Extract All



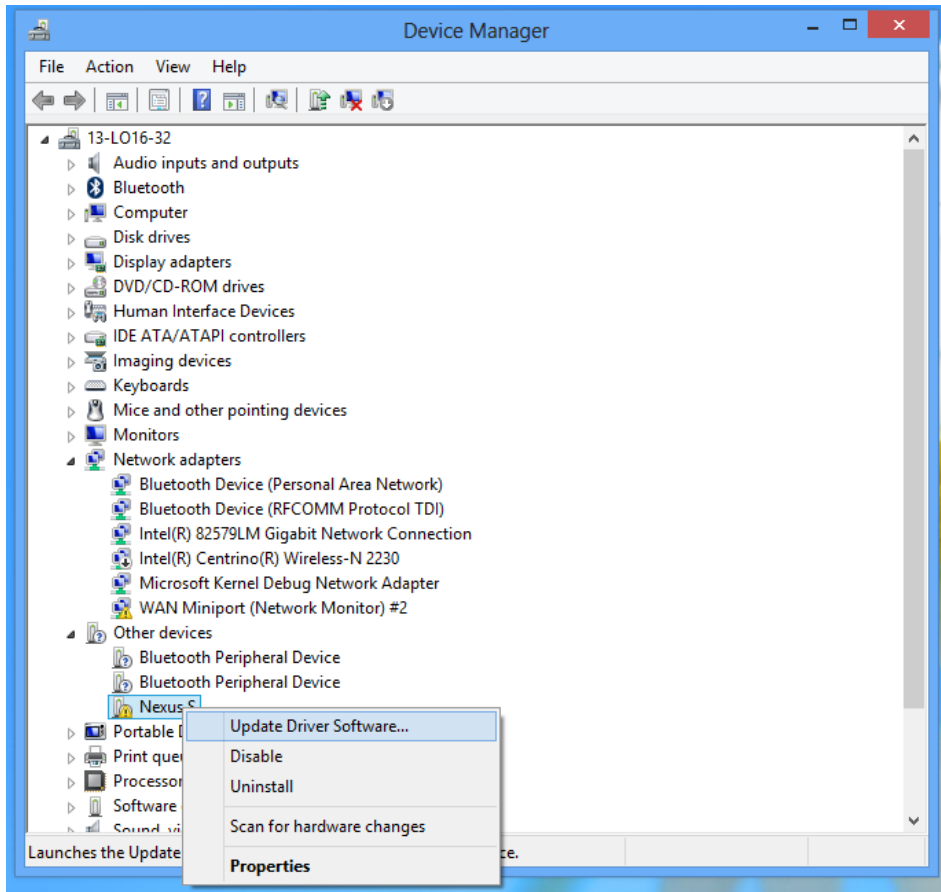
5. Select Extract.



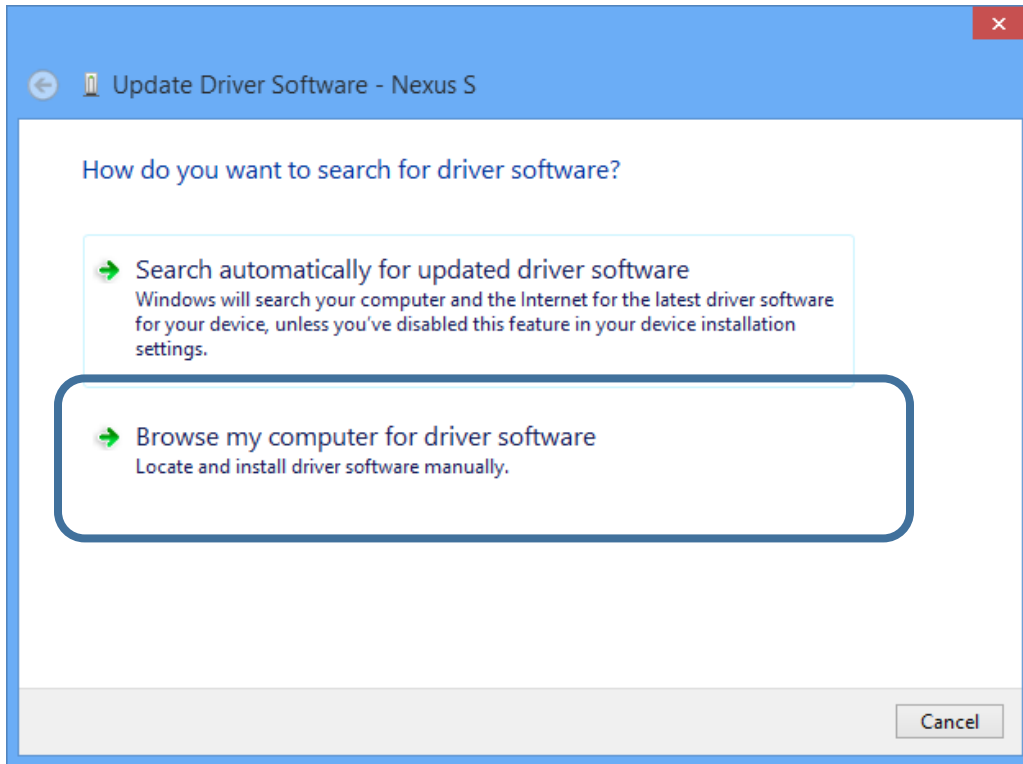
6. Plug the NEXUS Google Phone into the Computer. The computer will attempt to install the driver – you will need to wait several minutes for the process to complete.
7. Go to Device Manager (Mouse into lower left corner, right click and select Device Manager)



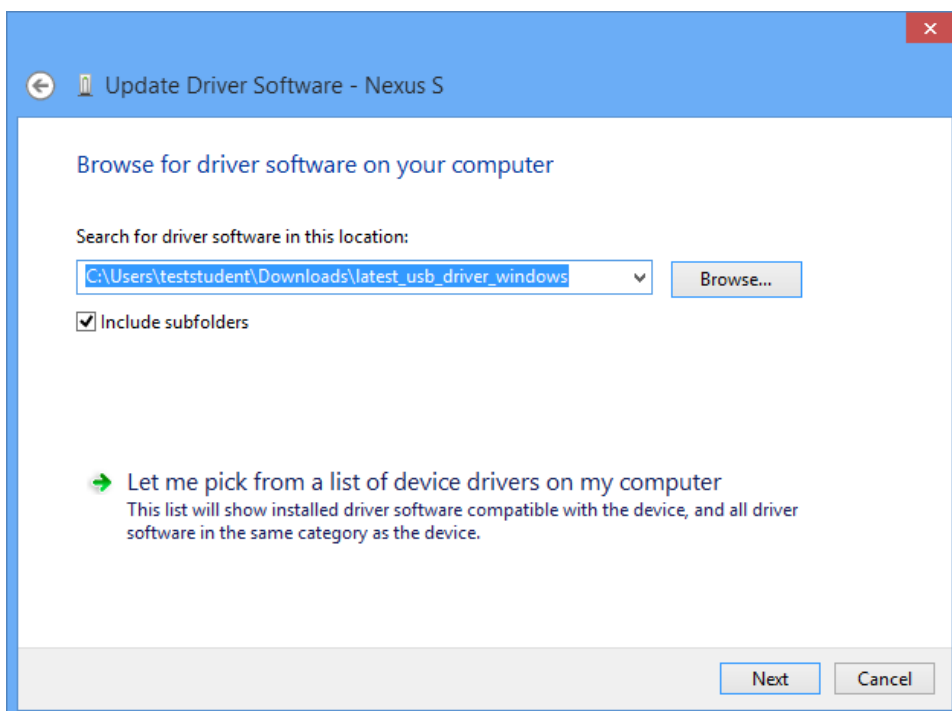
8. Locate the “Nexus S” on under “Other Devices” and Right Click. Select Update Driver Software:



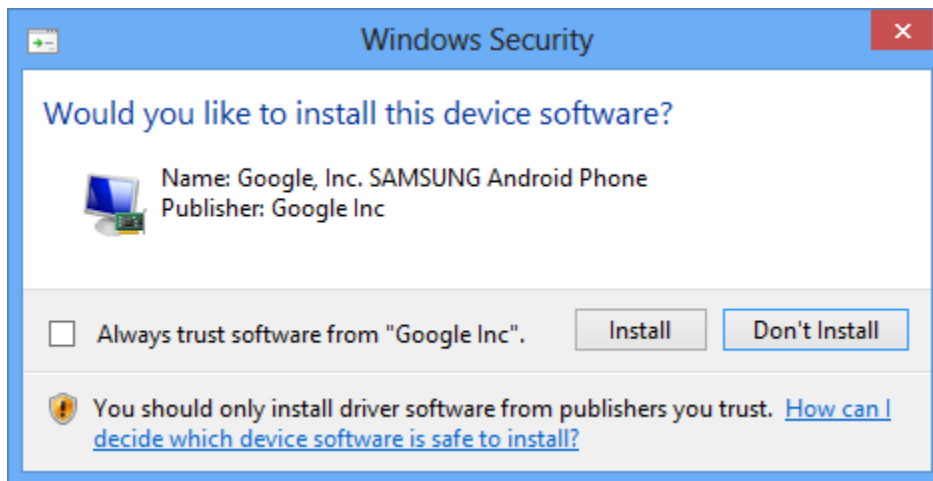
9. Select Browse my computer for driver software



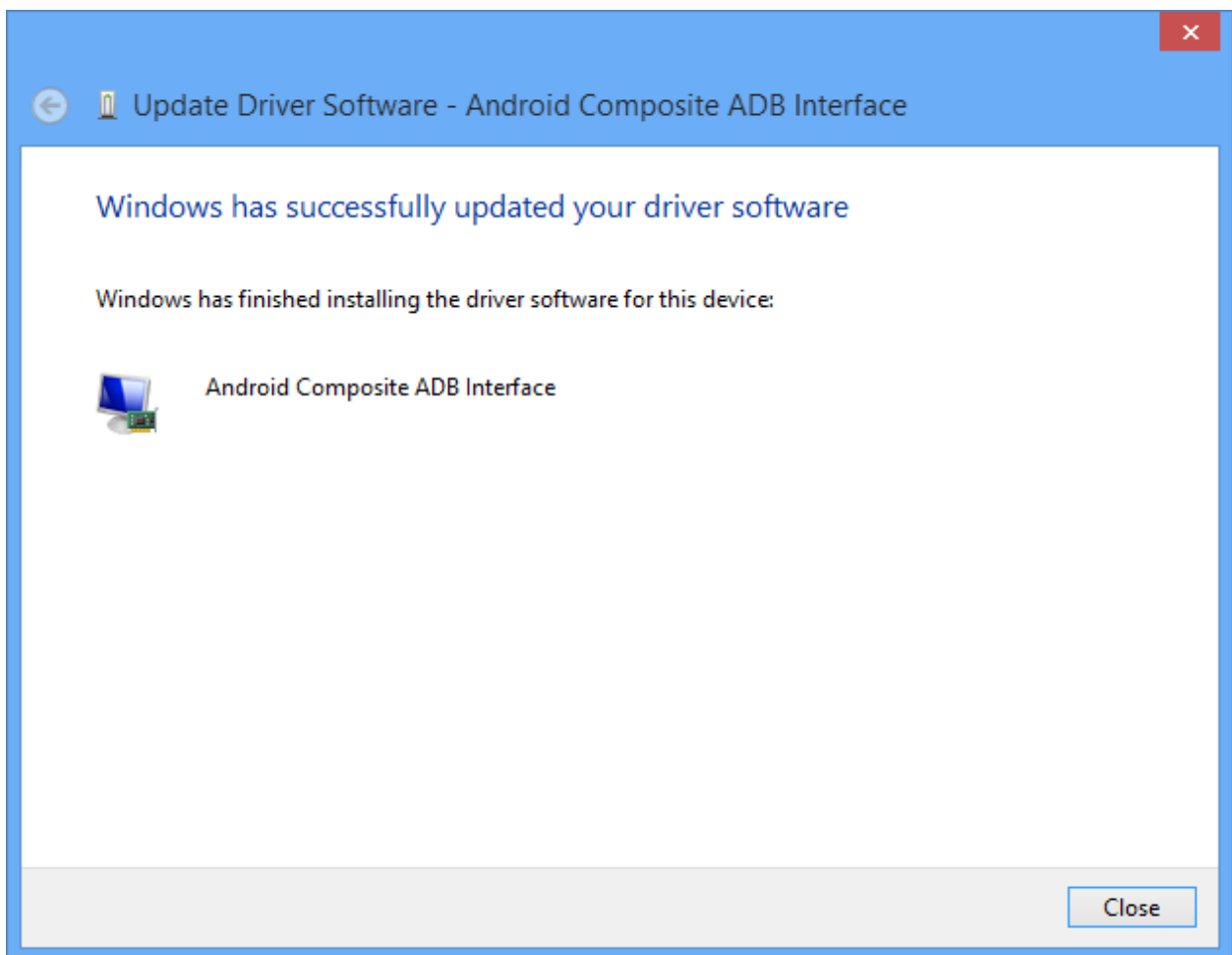
10. Click Browse and go to the Downloads folder and select the "latest_usb_driver_windows" folder we just extracted. Click "Next."



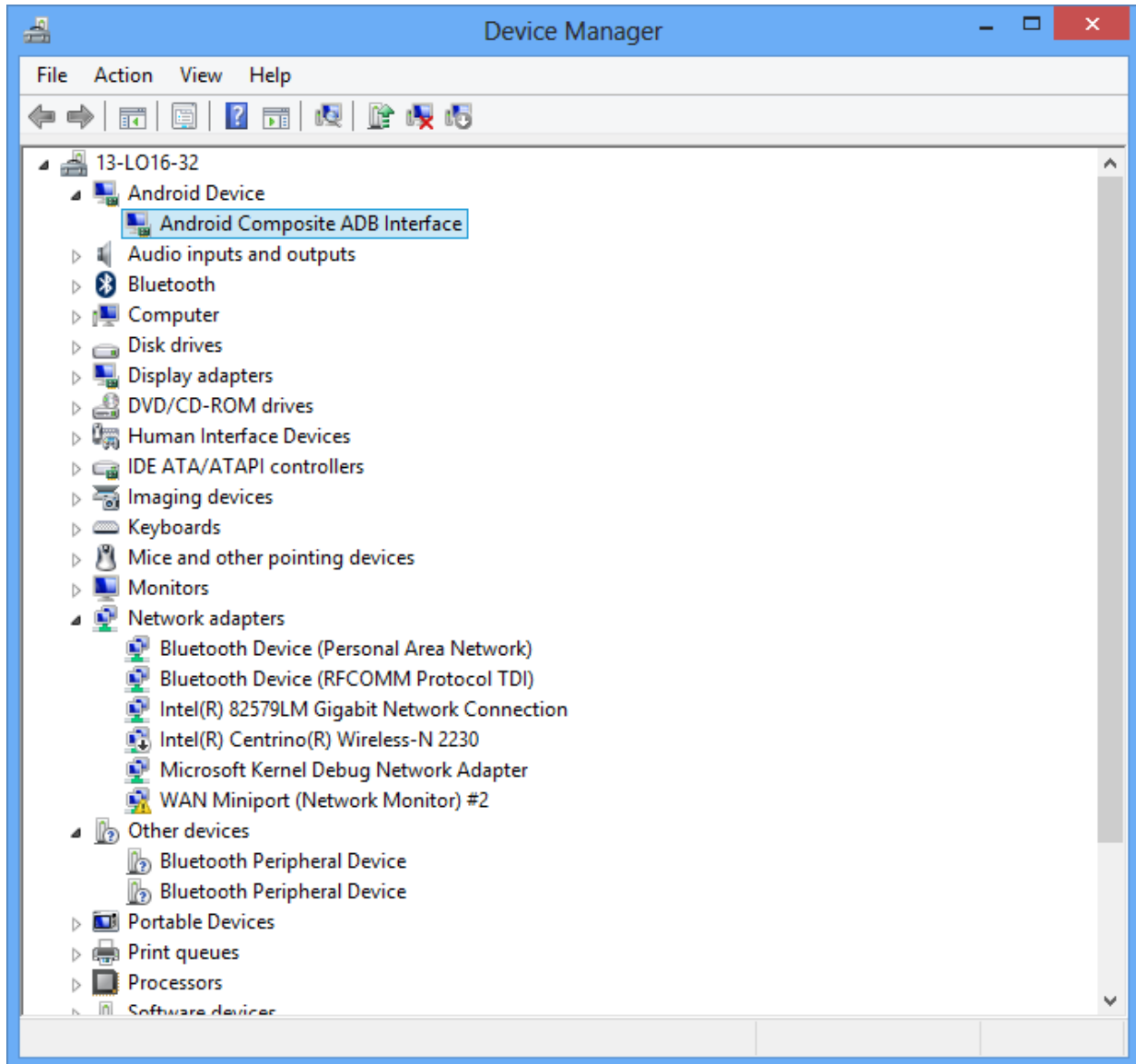
11. A Windows Security message will appear. Select "Install".



12. If the Install worked, you will see this screen:



13. Click Close and you will see that “Android Device” is now listed in the Device Manager.



14. Close the Device Manager and start Eclipse – you should be able to download your Apps onto the Phone.
